



## Dog Policy

Luccombe Manor Country House Hotel is the premier hotel on the Isle of Wight that welcomes dogs. Awarded the Woof Award for most dog friendly accommodation, we have tried to think of everything you will need to make the most of your holiday with us and best of all, you can even bring your humans with you!

If you are coming away with your well-behaved humans, make sure they let us know at the time of booking and we can make sure we have your doggie bed ready and waiting for you, along with an extra special gift bag if you are staying for a few nights!

We offer the following services for our four-legged friends, all included in the £15 per night charge:

Dog beds and blankets – in room & restaurant	Doggy welcome pack
Dog Towels for muddy paws	Enjoy breakfast with your dog
Doggy Shop with range of toys and treats	Doggy wash station
Food Storage and Prep Area	Doggy Bin on site

As one of our very welcome four-legged friends, you are allowed in the majority of our Standard rooms and in a selected few Sea Facing rooms. You also have full access to our cliff top gardens providing you keep your humans with you and on a lead at all times.

Following a recent cliff fall, direct beach access using the cliff steps at the bottom of our garden is currently closed. However, we have arranged complimentary passes with dog-friendly Shanklin Chine (which is less than 2 minutes walk from the hotel), to gain access to this tourist attraction which leads directly to the beach below. This can be accessed between 10am and 10pm from the end of March to the end of October.

When you return from your splash in the sea and chasing the gulls on the beach, we even have a special doggy wash station and doggy towels to dry you off afterwards. If you would prefer trying to spot and chase the red squirrels we would suggest Rylstone Gardens, directly opposite the hotel entrance, as a great place to start!

We do have a few "rules" that we would kindly ask you to observe, so don't forget to tell your humans about them:

- Please don't let your humans inadvertently leave you unattended in your room during the day. If you are a very well behaved doggy and need some rest from your humans, you may remain in your room for a short nap, provided your humans let Reception know, remain on site at either Luccombe Hall or Luccombe Manor and let us have their mobile contact number.
- You are welcome to explore all our grounds as long as you keep your humans on a lead. You may also take your humans into the outdoor pool area at Luccombe Manor only, but you must remain on a lead at all times and don't go in the pool as its only human friendly. We have provided ground clips for your safety. Luccombe Hall's outdoor pool area is strictly for humans only.
- At breakfast time you can remain with your humans whilst they enjoy their breakfast. Good doggies also get sausages too! You are also welcome to enjoy a take away from Luccombe Hall or elsewhere should your humans need feeding in the evening.
- If you feel like treating your humans to a special meal in the Grand View Restaurant at Luccombe Hall, they have a doggy dining area in their restaurant. You are welcome to allow your humans to enjoy a drink in the bar with you as well.
- As your humans are responsible for you, we ask that they always pick up after you and dispose in the bin provided at the entrance to Luccombe Manor car park.
- If you have an unfortunate accident, please ask your humans to advise a member of staff who will provide them with cleaning materials.
- Remember to be on your best behaviour as any damage you cause will need to be paid for by your humans.
